

Camp Battleship FAQ

Q. What is the maximum capacity per camping experience?

A. This Camp Battleship overnight program is a hybrid that adheres to physical distancing guidelines. Our outdoor spacing allows up to 45 guests total. Once 50% capacity indoors is permitted following guidelines from local and state authorities, then the capacity will be updated.

Q. How much is the deposit?

A. A deposit of \$270 is needed 3 weeks after booking to secure your reservation.

Q. Are meals provided?

A. We provide a catered dinner on the evening of arrival and a catered breakfast the following morning of your experience. Meals will be individually packed to adhere to the latest safety guidelines.

Q. What is the duration of the program?

A. Program starts at 5:00 pm and ends at 9:00 am the next day.

Q. What is your refund policy?

A. A full refund will be issued for the following: The Pacific Battleship Center cancels in the event that the minimum number of participants (25) is not met or inclement weather causes hazardous conditions.

No refunds will be issued if a group chooses to cancel their booked visit.
